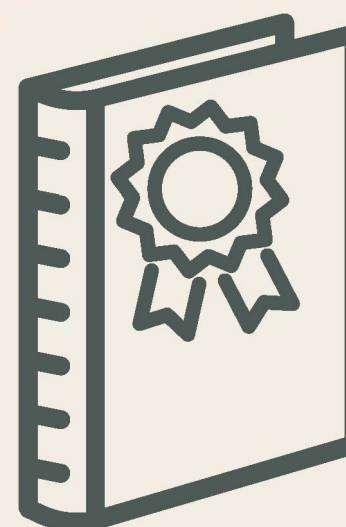

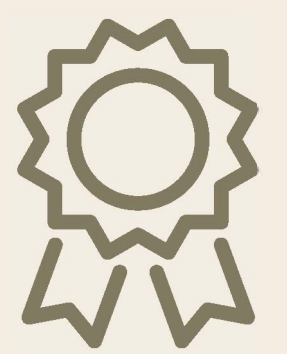
She served as a legal consultant, prosecutor and defence attorney in the IDF

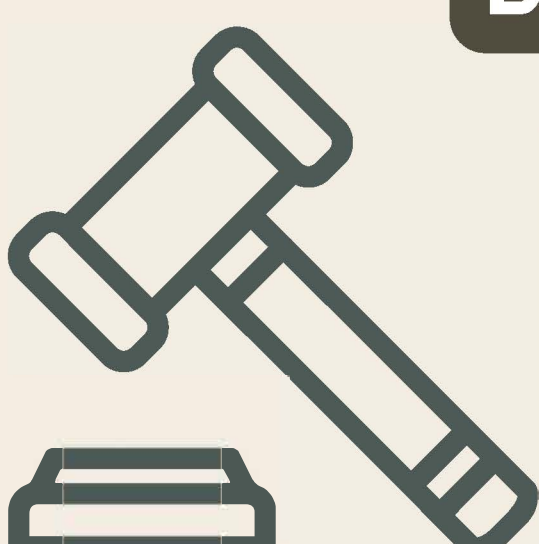
Was the director of Tebeka- An Organization for Advocacy, Equality and Justice for Ethiopian-Israelis
